**Meetings Schedule and Dress Code:**

You must have a valid excuse if you cannot attend meetings. Excuses must be emailed or texted in advance of the meeting. Examples of a valid excuse: sports team practice, cheer practice, band practice, other school function, sickness. Appointments should not be made on the dates of Chamber events or Youth Ambassador meetings.

- You are expected to assist as official ambassadors for chamber functions and events. You will be required to attend a certain number of events and meetings throughout 2022 and 2023 school year. You will have the opportunity to receive service hours, as chamber staff deems appropriate, for your service to our community. Two of the required events will be soft skills training. A certificate will be presented to all participants at the completion of the requirements.
- A Youth Ambassador shirt will be provided to you. Wear this shirt with khaki or black pants to all meetings and events. Some of our events are more casual and shorts with your Ambassador shirt will be allowed. You will be given prior notification.
- An identification badge will be provided to you. You must wear your badge to all meetings and events.

**Scholarship Opportunity:**

- A \$1,000 one-time scholarship will be awarded to one participant
- Must have a verifiable 2.5 grade average
- Scholarship recipient will be randomly chosen from the participants that have met all of the requirements
